<b>DESIGNATED OFFICERS</b> <b>37(2)(f)</b> The Commission may authorize a designated officer to make any order that an inspector may make under subsection 35(1) or (2).	
<b>PROCEDURES</b> <b>38</b> Every order of an inspector and every order of a designated officer under paragraph 37(2)(f) shall be made, and every measure under paragraph 37(2)(c), (d) or (g) shall be taken, in accordance with the <i>Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure</i> .	
<b>COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER</b> <b>41</b> Every person named in or subject to an order of the Commission, an inspector or designated officer shall, regardless of whether or not the person has had an opportunity to make representations with respect to the order, comply with the order within the time specified in it or, if no time is specified, immediately.
