Comment: It is not clear if section 3.2.2.2, 3.2.3.2, 3.2.5.2.1, 3.2.5.2.2, 3.2.6, 3.2.7 were written for category 4 and 5, they contains measures required for higher levels of security when they are matched with the content of the Table. The present interpretation would be to assume a universal approach to security when it is not the goal. Should the goal be to list a series of universal steps to security they must list only the items common to all categories. Section 3.2.8 is clearly not written for portable gauge users. To even contemplate this level of security would be an extreme burden for licensees.
