Thank you for the opportunity to comment on this draft.

- We do <u>not</u> believe that it is the responsibility of the Radiation Safety Committee (RSC) to "review and approve a budget for radiation safety and related training" as described on page 34 section D.1.4. In our case it is the RSC's role to advise Senior Management and/or the Applicant Authority what additional resources are required for Radiation Safety (e.g. funds for training, equipment and instruments, refresher training, etc).
- 2. We appreciate the fact that Appendix H: Classes of Nuclear Substances (page 86) now refers to F-18, C-11, O-15 and N-13 as class C nuclear substances.
