So "After closure there is no intention to retrieve...the radioactive waste". Earlier discussions held open the option of retrieving fuel waste for re-processing. Does this mean that 'closure' could be indefinitely delayed to maintain this option? If, during the pre-closure period, wastes were retrieved for reprocessing, would this be covered by a separate regulatory system? Would selection for a waste disposal site include evaluating the suitability of the site for an associated reprocessing plant?

Will baseline data include microbiological data at the depth at which waste would be stored?
