Re: Nordion Feedback on Industry Comments on Draft REDDOC - 2.2.2, Personnel Training

Dear Sir or Madam,

The purpose of this memorandum is to communicate feedback from Nordion (Canada) Inc. on the industry comments related to the draft CNSC document "REGDOC – 2.2.2, Personnel Training". These industry comments were posted on the CNSC website on July 17, 2013.

Upon review of the industry comments on the draft REGDOC -2.2.2, it is Nordion's position that improvements could be made to the definitions provided in the 'Glossary' section of the document. In particular, clear and perscriptive definitions should be included for the key terms, principles and requirements set out in the REGDOC.

In particular, the terms 'safety-sensitive occupation' and 'safety-sensitive position' should be better defined if they are ultimately retained in the final version of the document. For some terms, such as 'task element' a definition should be added to the document as none exists at present.

Nordion has no other feedback on the industry comments received on the draft "REGDOC – 2.2.2, Personnel Training".
