## Commission Ruling on Request to Protect Confidential Information

Requestor: Denison Mines Corporation

Matter: 25-H9 — Application for a Licence to Prepare Site and Construct the Wheeler

River Project

**Proceeding:** Two-Part Public Hearing in October and December 2025

With respect to the matter noted above, the Commission has considered Denison's <u>request for confidentiality</u><sup>1</sup> for the documents set out in Table 1, below. This request was made pursuant to rule 12 of the <u>Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure</u> (the *Rules*).

In its consideration of Denison's request for confidentiality, the Commission also considered CNSC staff's review<sup>2</sup> of Denison's request.

## The Commission is satisfied that:

- as per subrule 12(1)(a) of the Rules, documents 2-6 in Table 1 contain information that involves national or nuclear security; and
- as per subrule 12(1)(b) of the Rules, documents 1-7 in Table 1 contain confidential information of a financial, commercial, scientific, and/or technical nature that are treated consistently as confidential; and
- as per subrules 12(2)(a) and 12(2)(b) of the Rules, protection of the information outweighs in importance the public interest in public hearings and disclosure of evidence, and the measure taken is designed so as not to affect the public nature of the proceeding except to the extent necessary to adequately protect the information.

Therefore, applying subrules 12(3)(b) and 12(3)(c) of the *Rules*, the Commission orders that the publication or disclosure of information given to the Commission in documents 1-7 be prohibited, as described in Table 1.
