Please find below comments from Health Canada, Radiation Protection Bureau concerning the above referenced draft Regulations.

Section 8:

Current proposed text:

8 (1) Every licensee must use a licensed dosimetry service to measure and monitor the doses of radiation received by and committed to nuclear energy workers who have a reasonable probability of receiving

- (a) an effective dose that is greater than 5 mSv in a one-year dosimetry period; and
- (b) an equivalent dose to the skin, or the skin of hands and feet, that is greater than 50 mSv in a one-year dosimetry period

Comment. Clauses 8(1)a and 8(1)b should be independent, ie, a licensed dosimetry service should be used if either (a) or (b) is satisfied. The following change is suggested:

8 (1) Every licensee must use a licensed dosimetry service to measure and monitor the doses of radiation received by and committed to nuclear energy workers who have a reasonable probability of receiving

- (a) an effective dose that is greater than 5 mSv in a one-year dosimetry period; or
- (b) an equivalent dose to the skin, or the skin of hands and feet, that is greater than 50 mSv in a one-year dosimetry period
