Commission Ruling on Request to Protect Confidential Information

Requestor: Ontario Power Generation (OPG)

Matter: CMD 24-H102— OPG’s application to amend the Pickering Waste Management Facility (PWMF) licensing basis to process and store a maximum of 100 dry storage containers containing a minimum of 6-year cooled fuel at the PWMF

Date of proceeding: Written Hearing, to be held in June 2024
