Commission Ruling on Request to Protect Confidential Information under Rule 12, *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*

Requestor: Ontario Power Generation Inc.

Matter: 24-H3 — Ontario Power Generation's Application for a Licence to Construct a BWRX-300 Reactor at the Darlington New Nuclear Project

Proceeding: Two-Part Public Hearing, Part 1 held on October 2, 2024 and Part 2 to be held beginning on January 8, 2025

With respect to the matter noted above, the Commission has considered Ontario Power Generation's requests^{1,2,3,4} for the confidentiality of documents. These requests were made pursuant to rule 12 of the [Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure](#)⁵ (the Rules).

On October 29, 2024, the Commission issued a [Partial Record of Decision](#)⁶ on OPG's requests for confidentiality. In the Partial Record of Decision, the Commission ruled only on documents that it was satisfied contained information that pertained to national or nuclear security, per subrule 12(a) of the Rules. The documents not included in the Partial Record of Decision remained under the Commission's consideration, pending the receipt of additional information from OPG.

CNSC staff provided the Commission with its [review](#)⁷ of OPG's confidentiality requests on October 25, 2024. On October 29, 2024, the Commission [requested](#)⁸ that OPG provide additional justification to support its requests for confidentiality for the documents that were not addressed in the Partial Record of Decision. OPG provided the [requested information](#)⁹ on November 18, 2024. On November

The Commission appreciates the participation of all commenters and values the responses received. The submissions from all commenters were taken into consideration when weighing the requirements of Rule 12, including considering whether the protection of the information outweighs in importance the public interest in public hearings and the disclosure of information, and whether the measures are designed so as not to affect the public nature of the proceeding except to the extent necessary to adequately protect information.

- Items 1-22, 24, 29-48, 50-60, and 62-67

Where the Commission has ruled against the request for confidentiality, it has found that:

- the request does not meet the criteria set out in subrule 12(1)(a),(b), or (c) of the Rules; and
- the public interest in public hearings and disclosure of evidence outweighs the reasons given for the request to protect information.

Therefore, as per subrule 12(3)(b) of the Rules, the Commission has determined that it will not take measures to protect the confidentiality of the following documents that have not been granted confidentiality, as described in Table 1:

- Items 23, 25, 26, 27, 28, and 49

This Ruling means that the documents which are not protected by confidentiality will form part of the public record.

Should OPG wish to either:

- withdraw the document from the record; or
- substitute a redacted version of the document

it will have until **Monday December 2, 2024** to do so by communication with the Registry.

As of **December 3, 2024** any document where confidentiality has not been granted will be included in the public record, unless it is withdrawn or substituted.

OPG should understand that its withdrawal of any document would result in such document not forming part of the record in this matter and will therefore not be available for consideration by CNSC staff or the Commission. OPG should be aware this could affect the recommendations of CNSC staff and the evidence on which the Commission makes its findings.
