Ontario Power Generation Inc. Application to Renew the Nuclear Power Reactor Operating Licence for the Pickering Nuclear Generating Station

Following a hearing on April 4, 2018 and June 25 – 29, 2018, the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC), pursuant to section 24 of the *Nuclear Safety and Control Act*, renewed the Nuclear Power Reactor Operating Licence issued to Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) for its Pickering Nuclear Generating Station (PNGS) located in Pickering, Ontario. The renewed licence, PROL 48.00/2028, is valid from September 1, 2018 until August 31, 2028. With this decision, the Commission also authorized Ontario Power Generation Inc. to operate the PNGS Units 5 – 8 up to a maximum of 295,000 equivalent full power hours.

The following correction is required to the *Record of Decision* issued on December 20, 2018 by the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission.

On page 68 of the document, paragraph 331:

"The Commission directs OPG to submit implementation plans to CNSC staff and implement the updated CSA N285.4-14 and N284.4-13 as soon as practicable at the PNGS, and directs CNSC staff to provide annual updates in this regard through the NPP ROR or other means, as appropriate."

erroneously refers to CSA N284.4-13 and is therefore changed to:

"The Commission directs OPG to submit implementation plans to CNSC staff and implement the updated CSA N285.4-14 and N285.5-13 as soon as practicable at the PNGS, and directs CNSC staff to provide annual updates in this regard through the NPP ROR or other means, as appropriate."
