The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) announces a date change for the public hearing being held in May 2018 to consider an application from Bruce Power Inc. (Bruce Power) for the renewal of its Nuclear Power Reactor Operating Licence for the Bruce Nuclear Generating Stations (NGS) A and B for a period of 10 years.

In light of the number of interventions to be considered during the public hearing, two days (May 28 and 29) have been added to the hearing.
