Revision to upcoming public meeting notice on two-part regulatory oversight report

On November 5, 2020, the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a public meeting, where CNSC staff will present a two-part regulatory oversight report (ROR): *Part I, Use of Nuclear Substances in Canada: 2019*, and *Part II, Class IB Accelerators in Canada: 2018 and 2019*.

This ROR, available for review on the CNSC website, or on request to the Secretariat will now be available on **September 2**, instead of August 27. The deadline for the public to file a written submission on this ROR is now **October 13, 2020**.

Part I of this ROR provides CNSC staff's assessment of the safety performance of licensees in the medical, industrial, academic and research, and commercial sectors that used nuclear substances in Canada in 2019. Part II summarizes CNSC staff's assessment of the performance of the two Class IB accelerator facilities (TRIUMF and Canadian Light Source Inc.) in Canada in 2018 and 2019. There will be a presentation made, along with a plain-language executive summary, for each of these two parts.

The public meeting will be webcast live and available on the CNSC website at <u>nuclearsafety.gc.ca</u>.

Persons who have an interest or expertise in this matter are invited to comment, in writing, on the ROR by **October 13, 2020** using the <u>online request form</u> or the contact information below. The submission must include your name, address, telephone number and email address. In addition, the CNSC will allow Indigenous intervenors the opportunity to make oral presentations in the spirit of reconciliation and in recognition of the Indigenous oral tradition for sharing knowledge. Due to potential travel restrictions or limitations in relation to the COVID-19 pandemic, oral presentations will be conducted remotely.

All submissions will be available for download on the CNSC website or on request to the Secretariat. Personal information, such as address and telephone number, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.



To assist Indigenous peoples, members of the public and stakeholders in reviewing the ROR, and as previously set out in the notice of participation published on June 19, 2020, participant funding of up to \$20,000 was made available through the CNSC's <u>Participant Funding Program</u>. The deadline to submit a completed participant funding application form to the CNSC was July 20, 2020.
