## Revised Notice of Hearing

July 4, 2017 Ref. 2017-H109 Revision 1

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in August 2017 to consider an application from Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) to amend the nuclear power reactor operating licences for the Darlington Nuclear Generating Station (NGS) located in the Municipality of Clarington, Ontario and the Pickering NGS located in the City of Pickering, Ontario. The hearing to consider OPG's application had originally been scheduled for June 2017, but was rescheduled to August 2017 to allow members of the public to comment on the matter.

The proposed amendments would incorporate in the Pickering and Darlington nuclear power reactor operating licences activities that are currently authorized under a nuclear substance and radiation device licence to import and export nuclear substances in contaminated laundry, packaging, shielding or equipment. OPG has also requested additional licensed activities, which would allow contaminated laundry from the Western Waste Management Facility to be combined with Pickering laundry before it is shipped to the United States.

Pursuant to rule 3 of the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure* (the Rules), the Commission has decided to vary the Rules and to consider written submissions from OPG and CNSC staff, as well as written interventions from members of the public. A panel of the Commission will then deliberate and render a decision on OPG's application.

Pursuant to rule 19 of the Rules, members of the public who have an interest or expertise in this matter or information that may be useful to the Commission in coming to a decision are invited to comment, in writing, on OPG's application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Commission Secretariat by August 3, 2017, using the online request form or following the coordinates below. The request to intervene must include the following information:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- the requester's name, address and telephone number

All submissions are available to the public on request to the Secretariat. Personal information, such as address and telephone numbers, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.

The hearing submissions are not available on the CNSC website and must be requested through the Secretariat at the coordinates below.
