To Whom It May Concern;

I am writing you this letter in support of Bruce Power's Application for a 10-year license renewal. As a local charity based in Saugeen Shores, Ontario we have been the recipients of Bruce Power's extensive community engagement over the past five years. We are truly grateful for the support they give as a reputable community leader not only to us but many local non-profit and charitable organizations in the surrounding region. Having support from a company with integrity has helped our grass roots foundation grow.

The Liv-A-Little Foundation was started in 2013 after our oldest daughter Olivia was diagnosed with the rare genetic disease cystinosis. Since that time our Foundations mission has been committed to supporting the advancement of treatments and ultimately a cure for cystinosis by educating, promoting and funding progress.

Cystinosis is a rare, inherited metabolic disease in which the amino acid cystine gets into the cells, but has no transporter out. Because of the defect in transportation, the cell crystallizes causing early cell death. Cystinosis slowly destroys the organs in the body including the kidneys, liver, eyes, muscles and the brain. Currently there is no cure, only a time demanding, around the clock treatment. This is such a rare disease affecting such a small population, roughly 75 Canadians and only 2,000 worldwide, with an average life expectancy of 27. This is why we rely so heavily on the support of organizations like Bruce Power.

We have been tremendously fortunate to have partnered with Bruce Power as our title sponsor for our annual Swing, Shoot & Liv Golf Classic, their generosity and commitment has made this one of the most successful charity golf tournaments in the area.

Without the support from Bruce Power we would not be as successful as we are. Granting Bruce Power an operating licences renewal would not only benefit organizations like ours, but the overall economic



spin offs to our local communities through thousands of indirect jobs annuals, millions in labour income that will recycled throughout the economy. Our "Paint the Town Purple" campaign to raise awareness started with 13 local businesses and has grown organically by a proud community, a community that would not thrive without a company like Bruce Power.

We believe that Bruce Power's Safety record, emergency management processes, consideration for proper waste management, awareness for their thermal footprint and radiological emissions have been managed with over and above consideration to our local communities.




