On behalf of the Board of Directors of the Saugeen Memorial Hospital Foundation, I am writing this letter to express our support for Bruce Power's application for a 10-year operating license renewal.

Saugeen Memorial Hospital Foundation raises and manages funds for medical equipment, facility improvements and staff education for the Southampton and Owen Sound hospitals. We endeavour to create an engaged community dedicated to the vision of keeping health care close to home. We have one full time and one part time staff, a volunteer board of directors with 10 members and a team of approximately 100 volunteers that help with events, special projects and fundraising. We work closely with the management of Grey Bruce Health Services who determines the priority equipment needs of the corporation for which we fundraise.

Our relationship with Bruce Power is as a very close partner in our mandate to help keep health care close to home. Bruce Power provides financial support, shares the expertise of their staff and helps to engage the employees and their families in the work that we do.


