# Health & Safety

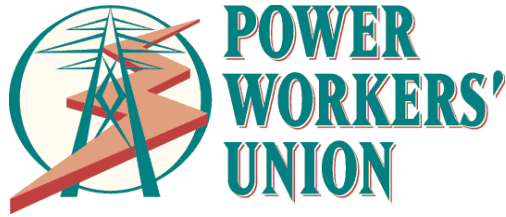
- Health and Safety of our members and the public
