I understand that the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission is considering an application by OPG to renew, for 10 years, the operating license of Pickering Nuclear Generating Station. As Chair of the Durham Nuclear Health Committee (DNHC), I offer the following written comments; I do not intend to make an oral presentation.

In 1995, the Council of the Regional Municipality of Durham created the DNHC to act as forum for primarily discussing and addressing radiological emissions from nuclear facilities in Durham Region to assess potential health effects. The DNHC has been fully engaged with several EAs/public consultations related to a number of OPG projects over the years. In addition, OPG has provided excellent support and responsiveness to the DNHC and the community, while providing many opportunities for feedback through the community consultation process.
