As a resident of Peterborough who gains my livelihood from the healing arts and teaching yoga within the community, I request that the license not be granted.

The facility where BWXT aims to process uranium into fuel pellets is located right in our town around the corner from where I work. The people who come to the healing centre have vulnerable health conditions, both physically and mentally, and any added risk that they associate with this location will have a negative impact on their involvement and their ability to heal and lead engaged and whole lives.

Working in the healthcare field, I am also concerned about the health impacts of having uranium being transported within the City, and processed there as its presence increases the risk of exposure, leakages, spills and contamination. This will adversely impact the health of the residents in the long run.
