Please do not renew the license of BWXT to process uranium at 1025 Lansdowne Ave., Toronto. Uranium is toxic, carcinogenic, and radioactive and it is extremely dangerous to have a uranium processing facility in a residential neighbourhood in the middle of Toronto, a densely populated city.
