My name is Miles Johnston and I have an invested interest in the safety of the neighbourhood surrounding BWXT. I grew up around the corner from the facility and attended Prince of Wales school.

I have seen Peterborough continue to grow around Ge Hitachi and BWXT for the span of my life. It makes sense that a community would grow around an industry providing many opportunities to the towns folk at a walking distance. Now times have changed, and Peterborough has grown and seen that everyone makes mistakes and they can be deadly. It is my request that BWXT not be granted a licence to produce pellets in the downtown core of Peterborough, and my recommendation that BWXT keep powdered uranium and liquid hydrogen a safe distance from a dense populous. A distance great enough that if a mistake were to happen the CNSC could feel they made the right choice by removing the risk. Which is the first step in risk prevention.
