RE: BWXT Licence Renewal (Hearing Ref. 2020 - H - 01)

Uranium pellets should not be manufactured in Peterborough.

I think that having a nuclear factory is dangerous environmentally for everyone in the large surrounding area – not just within a 2 km radius.

Even without an accident, having a nuclear facility in a residential neighbourhood is dangerous. Take the plant out of Peterborough.

It is irresponsible to bring this new kind of production into a populated area. Nobody wants this in our community. No one wants their kids to be exposed to uranium powder. There are two schools right up the street. Our kids should not be breathing in uranium powder. No one should.

This makes me feel sick. It doesn't just make me feel sick when I think of nuclear power, but nuclear itself will make us sick.

I feel powerless as a citizen that I don't have a say. When I say no, I need to be heard. This is my way to say no.

Take the manufacturing of uranium pellets somewhere else. We don't want it in Peterborough. No pellets in Peterborough.
