On behalf of Council, I am pleased to submit the Town of Deep River's intervenor comments to the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission regarding Canadian Nuclear Laboratories Operating Licence Renewal for the Chalk River Laboratories, located within the Town of Deep River.

Council for the Town of Deep River passed the following motion at a Special Council Meeting held on November 22, 2017:
