

To Whom It May Concern:

Re: Métis Nation Support for Phoenix ISR Project (Wheeler River) (the “**Project**”)

This letter is sent on behalf of the Métis Nation – Saskatchewan (“**MN-S**”); Uranium City, Local 50; Stony Rapids, Local 80; La Ronge, Local 19; Weyakwin, Local 16; Timber Bay, Local 20; Patuanak, Local 82; Ile a la Crosse, Local 21; Canoe River, Local 174; Jan’s Bay, Local 38; Beauval, Local 37; Cole Bay, Local 41; Dore/Sled Lake, Local 67; Green Lake, Local 5; Northern Region 1; and Northern Region 3 (the “**Métis Nation**”). The Métis Nation have concluded an agreement with Denison Mines Corp. (“**Denison**”) in respect of the Project (“**Agreement**”). The Agreement provides, among other matters, for various procedural and substantive commitments by Denison to the Métis Nation that satisfactorily addresses the Métis Nation’s concerns regarding the Project, including in the context of the Métis Nation’s Aboriginal rights and interests under section 35 of the *Constitution Act, 1982*.



The Métis Nation confirms that, subject to Denison materially fulfilling its commitments under the Agreement, the Métis Nation consents to and supports the Project and intends to continue to participate in the ongoing regulatory approval processes for the Project in a manner consistent with our obligations in the Agreement.
