Dear Jude;

In follow up to your e-mail, I write to confirm that NexGen will not be modifying its request for confidentiality.

As outlined in NexGen's submission, the *Nuclear Substance and Radiation Device Management* procedure is a lower-level management system document not intended for public consumption. It has been developed using NexGen expertise and is considered proprietary and confidential; providing competitors with access to this information could compromise NexGen's competitive advantage. The document was labelled as 'transitory' for the specific purposes of making it available to CNSC staff for early review and feedback as part of the licence application process only – through discussions with CNSC staff, including correspondence exchanged with CNSC staff through the licence application process, NexGen understood that documents labelled as 'transitory' were not formally filed in the CNSC eDoc system and thus not subject to public posting.

Further, NexGen is not aware of any other uranium mine and mill licence applicant or licensee posting procedure-level documentation as part of the CNSC public hearing process. NexGen considers the information provided in the publicly posted *Rook I Radiation Protection Program* and available in the governing legislation (e.g., *Nuclear Substances and Radiation Devices Regulations*) – with which NexGen would be required to comply – to be adequate for the purposes of satisfying public interest.

If you should require anything additional of NexGen at this time, please let me know.
