My Name is Candace Neveau

As an Anishinaabe woman and young mother I would like to speak in the upcoming hearing, I am saying no to grant a 10 year licence for the Chalk River site and that the current licence be extended for a short period of time, no longer than 18 months. I am concerned for my children's health and safety, it is alarming to learn more of the unsafe events of Nuclear energy.

1. Chalk River should not be considering the creation of more nuclear waste. All Indigenous communities are in opposition to have the Nuclear waste be buried in our territories now. What will we do with 5 generations of the new Nuclear waste produced in the future? Just because it is the easiest route to dump waste in Indigenous territories doesn't make it right.
2. It is irresponsible to our future generations. Nuclear power generation risks the health of so many innocent species children to leave them with such a dangerous mess to clean. Our Anishinaabe teachings tell us to always consider 7 generations ahead and 7 generations behind and this Nuclear licence will lock us in for 5 generations of dangerous Nuclear power generations. How is this right? Indigenous people have always caught the brim end of things, how is this reconciliation or is that a lie.
