Prince of Wales Public School & BWXT Partnership - Intervention Report 2026

The partnership between **Prince of Wales Public School** and **BWXT Nuclear Energy Canada** in Peterborough is a strong example of how local industry and schools can work together to support student learning, creativity, and community connection.

BWXT has been an active and generous community partner, helping enhance both the learning environment and opportunities available to students here at our school. Over the years, employees and volunteers from BWXT have worked alongside the school community to build and install **garden boxes**, creating hands-on outdoor learning spaces where students can explore nature, sustainability, and environmental stewardship.



As part of ongoing support for Prince of Wales Public School, BWXT volunteers braved the heat of the summer to help brighten up the playground. Employees spent the afternoon refreshing faded lines on the basketball court, four square, track and field area, and more - in addition to painting a new pick-up zone for parents and tic-tac-toe in the kindergarten area. The fresh paint, along with the garden boxes they recently installed, will help create a more fun, functional, and safe space for students to enjoy when they return to school in the fall.



Beyond improvements to the physical environment, BWXT has made meaningful contributions to student learning by **funding STEAM resources** that support education in science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics. The company also hosted a **Science and Career Fair for intermediate students**, giving learners the opportunity to explore future career pathways, meet professionals in technical fields, and see how classroom learning connects to real-world applications.



Most recently, BWXT further strengthened this partnership through the **donation of two science kits**, providing students with new tools to investigate scientific concepts through hands-on experimentation.

These initiatives reflect BWXT's broader commitment to community engagement and education in Peterborough, where the company employs hundreds of skilled workers in engineering, manufacturing, and technology roles and has long supported local learning initiatives.

Together, Prince of Wales Public School and BWXT demonstrate how partnerships between schools and local organizations can enrich student experiences, inspire curiosity, and help young people imagine their future in science, technology, and beyond.
