Written Submission: As a volunteer member of the Community Liaison Committee (CLC) for BWXT's Toronto facility, I would like to share my perspective on the operation and management of the site. During the past three years serving on the CLC, I have had the opportunity to tour the facility and participate in both virtual and in-person meetings at the Toronto location. These experiences have provided valuable insight into the facility's operations and its approach to managing nuclear-related activities. What has impressed me most is the management team's commitment to openness and public engagement. They have consistently provided detailed presentations outlining how the facility operates and how nuclear materials are handled in a safe and responsible manner. In addition, the facility's proactive outreach efforts—such as hosting open houses and encouraging participation in the Community Liaison Committee—demonstrate a genuine commitment to transparency and meaningful dialogue with the community regarding their day-to-day operations. I have also had the opportunity to observe emergency preparedness training exercises conducted in collaboration with the local fire department. These exercises reflect a high level of coordination and preparedness, reinforcing the facility's strong emphasis on safety and emergency response readiness.
