Upcoming public meeting on BWXT Nuclear Energy Canada Inc.'s mid-term update on licensed activities at its Toronto and Peterborough facilities

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will conduct a public meeting in May 2026, at which BWXT Nuclear Energy Canada Inc. (BWXT NEC) will provide a mid-term update on licensed activities at its [Toronto](#) and [Peterborough](#) facilities. The BWXT NEC Toronto facility is located in the traditional territory of many nations, including the Mississaugas of the Credit, the Anishnabeg, the Chippewa, the Haudenosaunee and the Wendat peoples, and now home to many diverse First Nations, Inuit and Métis peoples. The BWXT Peterborough facility is situated on the Treaty 20 Michi Saagiig territory and the traditional territory of the Williams Treaties First Nations.

BWXT NEC holds 2 separate Class IB licences for its Toronto and Peterborough facilities. Both licences expire on [December 31, 2030](#), and authorize BWXT NEC to manufacture Canada Deuterium Uranium (CANDU) nuclear fuel bundles. The Toronto facility produces uranium dioxide fuel pellets, and the Peterborough facility manufactures fuel bundles using the pellets from Toronto. The Peterborough facility also manufactures zircalloy tubes and operates a fuel service business. The mid-term update will cover the first 5 years of the 10-year licensing periods for both facilities.

In addition to the update from BWXT NEC, CNSC staff will present an assessment of BWXT NEC's performance over the current licence periods for both facilities.

Participant funding

In advance of the meeting, the CNSC is making up to \$75,000 in funding available through its [Participant Funding Program](#). The purpose of the funding is to assist Indigenous Nations and communities, members of the public and interested parties in reviewing BWXT NEC's mid-term update and associated documents, and in participating in the Commission meeting process by providing topic-specific interventions to the Commission. Participant funding applications must clearly demonstrate how the proposed submission will provide the Commission with information directly related to BWXT NEC's mid-term update. Please note that the funding will be disbursed among all successful applicants. The deadline for submitting a completed participant funding application form to the CNSC is **January 23, 2026**.

Interventions

Persons who have an interest or expertise in this matter are invited to comment, in writing, on BWXT NEC's safety performance over the current licensing periods. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Commission Registry by **April 17, 2026**, by using the [online request form](#), emailing the Registry at interventions@cnscccsn.gc.ca, or using the contact information below. In addition, the CNSC will offer the opportunity to make oral presentations. Oral presentations may be conducted remotely. **The request to intervene must include the following information:**

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission, including an appendix with all documents mentioned as references in the written submission
- the requester's name, address, telephone number and email address

All submissions will be available for download on the CNSC website at cnscccsn.gc.ca or upon request to the Commission Registry.
