The Radiation Protection Program is capable of being effectively implemented and is managed by a person with sufficient knowledge, time and resources, and 2. All Notices of Non-Compliance cited in the Preliminary Inspection Report D-60443-PL-241023-1R have been addressed to the satisfaction of the CNSC. Sunshine Coast Materials Testing Ltd. is not permitted to transport portable gauges until it demonstrates full compliance with the Packaging and Transport of Nuclear Substances Regulations, 2015, and the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations.
