CANADIAN NUCLEAR SAFETY COMMISSION (CNSC)

- An independent agency of the Government of Canada – 75 years of experience
- Reports directly to Parliament through the Minister of Natural Resources
- Federal and provincial partners have jurisdiction for related activities/aspects



OUR MANDATE

- Regulate the use of nuclear energy and materials to protect health, safety, security and the environment
- Implement Canada's international commitments on the peaceful use of nuclear energy
- Disseminate objective scientific, technical and regulatory information to the public



COMMISSION MEMBERS



- Quasi-judicial administrative tribunal
- Agent of the Crown (duty to consult)

- Decisions reviewable by Federal Court
- Independent, part-time Commission members




