## Revised Notice of Public Hearing

March 1, 2018 Ref. 2018-H-02 Revision 1

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) announces the location for Part 2 of the public hearing to consider an application from Bruce Power Inc. (Bruce Power) to renew its Nuclear Power Reactor Operating Licence for the Bruce Nuclear Generating Stations (NGS) A and B for a period of 10 years. Bruce NGS A and B are located in the Municipality of Kincardine, ON.

The current licence, which expires on May 31, 2020, allows Bruce Power to operate the Bruce NGS A and B site, which consists of eight nuclear power reactor units and their associated equipment. It does not authorize Bruce Power to carry out life extension activities. With this 10-year licence renewal application, Bruce Power has requested authorization to update the Bruce NGS licensing basis in 2018 to include life extension projects and future major component replacement work, which are outlined in the Integrated Implementation Plan.

Members of the public who have an interest or expertise in this matter or information that may be useful to the Commission in coming to a decision are invited to comment on Bruce Power's application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Commission Secretariat by **April 16**, **2018** using the <u>online request form</u> or the contact information below. Pursuant to the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*, the request to intervene must include the following information:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only, or by way of written submission and oral presentation
- the requester's name, address and telephone number
